

PERSONAL VEHICLE TAGS

Who gets the personal tags?

1. An employee driving their personal vehicle
2. A Consultant driving their personal vehicle
3. An owner that is driving his/her personal vehicle
4. Welders that only own one vehicle

Who CAN'T get the personal vehicle tags?

1. Do not give these tags to vehicles that are driven by different employees.
 - a. The tag is specific to the person driving it.

What information do they need for a personal tag?

1. Employee's Personal Vehicle
 - a. Online application
 - b. Current vehicle registration
 - c. Current insurance card
 - d. Driver's license
 - e. Employer's TERO Business license
 - f. Tag expires the month the employee comes in to receive it
2. Consultant's Personal Vehicle
 - a. Online application
 - b. TERO Business License
 - c. Current Certificate of Liability Insurance with MHA DOT listed as the certificate holder and must have general & auto liability insurance in a minimum of one million coverage
 - d. Tag expires the month that is listed on their business license
3. Company owner's vehicle driven by just the owner
 - a. Current vehicle registration
 - b. Add under the Company's application (does not need to be a separate application)
 - c. Tag expires the month that is listed on the company TERO business license
4. Welder driving their Personal Vehicle
 - a. Online application
 - b. Business License from TERO
 - i. (must be in the welder's name or their company name)
 - ii. w2 welders fall under #1 above
 - c. Current Certificate of Liability Insurance with MHA DOT listed as the certificate holder and must have general & auto liability insurance in a minimum of one million coverage
 - d. Tag expires the month that is on their business license
